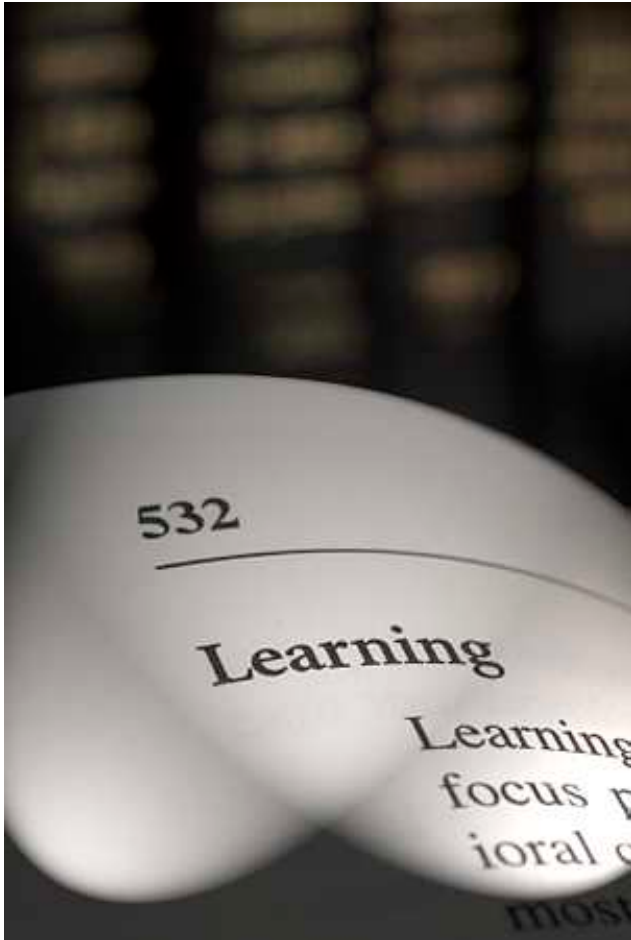

- In plenary sessions and workshops we demonstrate useful techniques, but more room is left for exercises and discussions in workshops.

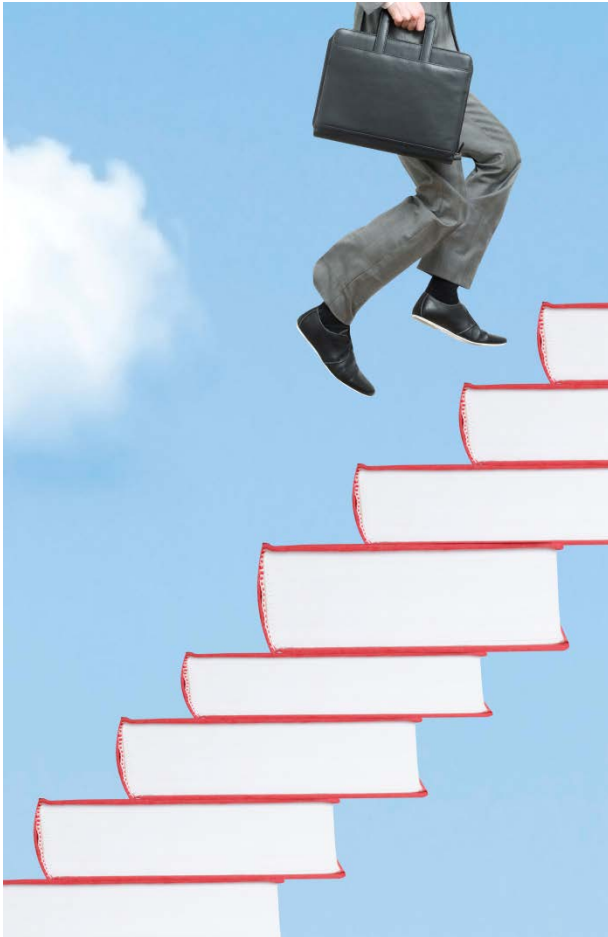


Expected outcomes - Transferrable skills

 - ▣ evaluating individual researchers and institutions (science indicators)

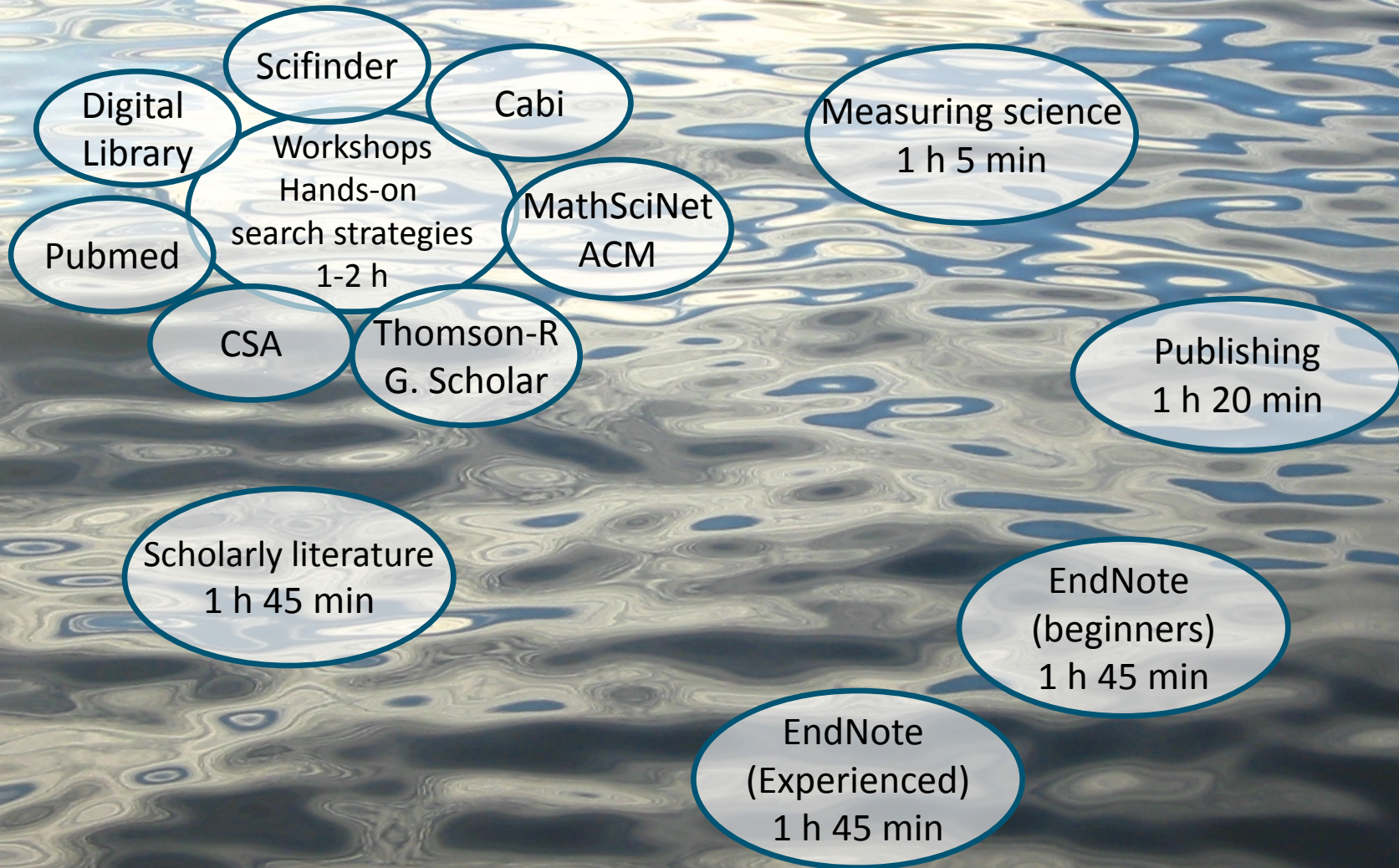


Expected outcomes - Transferrable skills
